"He, who has gone, so we but cherish his memory, abides with us, more potent, nay, more present than the living man." May his soul rest in eternal peace.

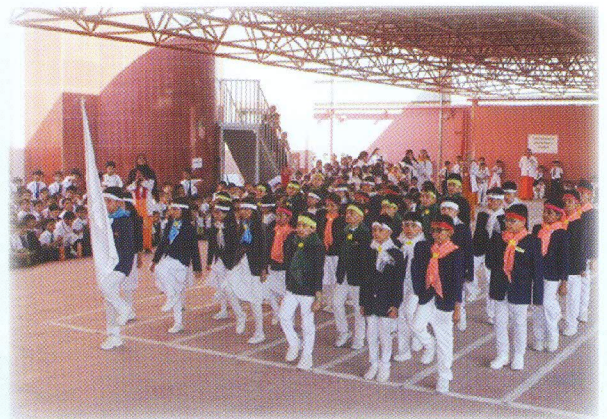
Giving Wings to Imagination
